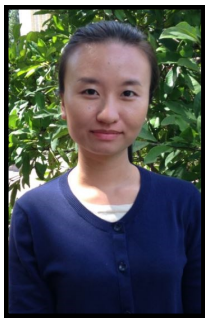


DEPARTMENT NEWS (CONT.)
