

This award, sponsored by Division 35, either alone or with other groups, recognizes work relevant in some significant way to women's lives or to the psychological understanding of gender role influences on human behavior.

Dr. Paschal Sheeran, Professor of Social Psychology, is the recipient of a 2021 National Cancer Institute R01 grant. The R01 provides support for health-related research and development based on the mission of the National Institutes of Health. Dr. Sheeran received a total award of over \$960,000 (over three years) for his project, "State-of-the-Art Synthesis of Interventions to Promote Quit Intentions and Smoking Cessation."

Congratulations to 2 Psychology and Neuroscience faculty members who are our 2021 recipients of the Stephenson and Lindquist awards! This award mechanism is a departmental funding award and its purpose is to support the research activities of our faculty. Dr. Monica Gaudier-Diaz, Teaching Assistant Professor, received \$2,000 to cover publication costs associated to the dissemination of novel teaching tools being used in her neuroscience courses, fund materials that will allow for more comprehensive course-based undergraduate research experiences, and support her professional development. Dr. Andrea Hussong, Professor of Clinical Psychology, received \$16,000 for her pilot study that aims to test the feasibility and preliminary effectiveness of virtual reality as a parent training tool for parents in recovery from opioid addiction.

## Early Childhood Depression

Duke University's Center for Child and Family Policy is hosting "Early Childhood Depression: What We Know and Where We're Going" featuring Dr. Michael Gaffey on November 10 from 3—4:30 pm. The event will be held on Zoom and also oncampus in Sandford 201. Dr. Gaffey, Assistant Professor at Duke University, will share a rapidly growing body of data indicating that the origins of depression are developmental in nature and identifiable as early as the preschool period. He will discuss the presentation and developmental course of preschool depression, highlight novel neuroimaging findings informing the neurobiological correlates of early risk for depression in young children, and discuss recent work investigating early intervention for preschoolers with depression.
